Celebrating 10+ years of grassroots community service, helping since 2014.

Since 2014, The Essentials Collective Inc has been helping to bring hygiene dignity to those in need across Perth.

What began as a passion project by a group of committed volunteers in 2014 has transformed into an integral community service trying to meet Western Australia's ever-increasing demands from homelessness, domestic violence and disadvantage.

In recent years, The Essentials Collective has transformed from a founder-led project to a sustainable operation with robust governance, embedded processes, and strong partnerships with our volunteers, beneficiaries, community supporters and funders.

We strive to minimise waste and only deliver what our beneficiaries need, when they need it. Meanwhile, we collect and store essential items in our warehouse space generously provided by Ability WA.

The Essentials Collective offers a simple solution for complex times.

Homelessness and disadvantage will continue in WA. People will always need the essentials. Our aim is to sustain our operations and stretch our reach across WA.

## **OUR CAMPAIGNS**

The majority of our donations are driven through two annual campaigns that engage the local community with specific calls for support.



In the last 12 months, we have collected and distributed more than \$48,000 worth of products through our structured campaigns, community minded donation box hosts, generous public donations, and enthusiastic volunteer energy!

It's a winning combination which drives us to make a tangible difference to WA's disadvantaged.

Donated items are distributed throughout WA to local crisis accommodation, drop-in centres and outreach services.

We focus on supporting people who are rough sleeping or experiencing housing insecurity, those in crisis accommodation due to domestic violence, at-risk youth, and individuals in need of drug and alcohol rehabilitation or refugee support.

Our Collection Campaign in March/April,
Collecting the Basics strives to support hygiene
and keep people warm and dry over the cooler
months, with a collection of winter items such as
socks and beanies in addition to toiletries.





Our Collection Campaign drive in August/September, Collecting the Essentials ensures that people in need have access to items that support personal hygiene, such as soap, shampoo and sanitary items.

Funding would also support The Essential Collective's membership to Volunteering WA, enabling The Essential Collective's to access expertise and the continued professional approach to volunteering.

**More Beneficiaries**: Increase the positive impact of The Essential Collective's through liaison with more Beneficiaries across WA. More funding will allow greater reach and support across the state. The need continues to grow.

**More Donation Boxes**: Increase the reach and number of Donation Box hosts and community engagement through promotional and other resources to promote, deliver, pick up and engage with donation box hosts.

**Synergy with other organisations**: The Essential Collective's currently partners with Ability WA who provide storage and sorting warehouse space as well as their wonderful supported employees who actively participate in the sorting sessions, aiding in both their skill development and capacity building. The Essential Collective's would welcome finding and leveraging synergy with other organisations to minimise waste and maximise opportunities.
